SECONDARY PARENTS' WEEKLY SHEET

March 12th 2015

Dear Parents: We hope that the following gives a flavour of some of this week's studying:

Arabic:

77 درس الطلبة قصيدة شعريّة عنوانها "نجوى أسير" للشاعر أبو فراس الحمداني. بالتاس قويدة شعريّة عنوانها "اللغة العربيّة تعانى أذاءها" الشاعر حافظ الراهد.

Art and Design Technology: Students are learning to draw their city designs in 2 point perspective.

They are creating a 3D city scape using colour, texture and pattern, depth and detail. Senators have been making frames for their Red Nose Day photo booth.

<u>Computing:</u> This Year 7 explored conditional formatting as part of the project: Spy School Spreadsheets.

Year 8 worked on Sound Effect Story, planning an animated story that they can then add sound effects and narration to. Year 9 worked on flash animation which will lead on to website design.

Drama: Year 8 watched their slapstick performances and assessed their group work and performance

skills. Year 9 filmed their different comedy genres, which is loosely based on the ball scene from 'Romeo and Juliet'.

English: Year 7 watched a TED award speech about food and diet and are now preparing their own speech in response to: Should children be banned from buying junk food? Year 8 finished filming their TV adverts which will be edited using Windows Moviemaker, and also undertook formal letter writing assignments. Year 9 planned their comparative essay in answer to the statement: Mary Maloney and Mrs Werle acted on impulse when they felt threatened. Additionally, they prepared material for an assignment in relation to 'War Horse' – writing diary entries as Captain Jamie Stewart at the end of Chapter 6.

<u>French:</u> Year 7 French studied how to talk about what they do and don't do at home. Year 8 began recording their presentations in French about their visit (imaginary or real) to a city or country. Year 9 are learning to talk about what they do and should do (!) to keep fit and stay healthy. Year 7 Spanish are discussing their subjects and what they like and dislike to study in school. Year 8 are learning to

say what they do in the classroom and to understand how regular verbs work.

<u>Geography:</u> KS 3 Geography students are close to finishing their term 2 topics ready for Assessment next Wednesday. Assessments will

be based on the following topics: Year 7 – Glaciers, Year 8 – Weather, Year 9 - International Development.

<u>History:</u> Year 7 researched different historic mosques from around the world. Year 8 examined working conditions for children in 19th century Britain. Year 9 have been studying the opening phase of World War Two, including the tactics of Blitzkrieg.

<u>Islamic Studies:</u> this week we have revised for assessments in years 7, 8 and 9.

Maths: Year 9 worked on algebraic graphs and preparing for assessment. Year 8 Jasmine finished their algebra topic. They will have a unit test on Sunday and then the new topic of Geometry. Year 7 Aloe finished their assessment on Statistics and are now working on Decimals. 7 Cinnamon explored surface area and volume, manipulating nets to form cuboids. Year 8 Orchid were tested on probability and then moved on to look at calculating averages. The students are working very hard!

<u>Music</u>: Year 7 worked on their own drum compositions in groups. Year 8 continued their new topic: Blues Music; they revised the 12 bar Blues chord progression on keyboards and attempted improvising using the Blues scale. Year 9 listened to the recordings of their

cartoon sound tracks and wrote a self-evaluation on the topic.

<u>PE</u>: Students are linking their Athletics and Swimming units of work together by competing in an Inter-Class Aquathlon. Next week students need to bring in for their Swimming lesson (in addition to their swimming kit) a running kit (top, shorts trainers)

to their swimming kit) a running kit (top, shorts, trainers). **Science:** Year 7 and 8 enjoyed a visit to the zoo and also worked hard in lessons on practicals.

<u>Social Studies</u>: Year 9NNSS have been looking at the Middle East as a region and examining the physical and human characteristics. We have been reviewing the connection between the UAE and other Middle Eastern nations.
